

Privacy Policy

Visitors to our website

When someone visits our sites we collect standard internet log information and visitor details of behaviour patterns. We do this to find out things such as the number of visitors to the different parts of the site. We collect the information in a way that does not identify anyone. If we do want to collect personally identifiable information through our website, we will make the purpose clear.

Use of Cookies and Web Storage Objects

Cookies and Web Storage Objects are small files placed on your device's storage. These enable our websites to identify your device, as you view different pages on our website.

These types of files also allow websites and applications to store your preferences in order to present content, options or functions that are specific to you. They enable us to see information such as how many people use the website, what pages they tend to visit or to attempt to display information that is most relevant to you.

Cookies and Web Storage Objects do not provide us with access to your device or any other information about you other than that which you choose to share with us.

By using your browser controls, you are always in control of the Cookies and Web Storage Objects we store and access on your computer.
